Dear Senator Rockefeller:

The purpose of this letter is to acknowledge receipt of your letter of February 3, 1998, to Dr. Bernard Rostker. We agree the Gulf War veterans' inpatient records addressed in your letter may supplement the medical information provided to patients incident to inpatient hospitalizations. These records, which were recently reviewed during our ongoing investigation, may provide additional information to those veterans who were hospitalized and do not have their personal medical records. We are preparing a plan to notify Gulf War veterans of the records and of the process to follow to access the records. We intend to coordinate our plan with the National Archives and Records Administration. We will keep you informed of our progress and will provide our plan just as soon as it is available.
